

ou've been demanding them for years, and they're finally here: LEGO sets from the Indiana Jones movies have arrived! We spoke with one of the designers of these action-packed models about just what went into translating Indy's adventures from the big screen to the LEGO brick.

DESIGNER PROFILE

Name: Adam Grabowski **LEGO Designer** Job: Designed: 7623 Temple Escape

Adam came to The LEGO Company from the University of Wuppertal in Germany, where he studied design. Before working on LEGO Indiana Jones, he created design sketches for **EXO-FORCE, LEGO Star** Wars™ and more.

(II) How is a LEGO Indiana Jones set designed?

(I) The process usually begins with collecting all of the movie material that we could possibly need. Then the whole team brainstorms together about what scenes can be done in LEGO bricks. We make sketches, test them with kids, and if we're happy with the results, we take the 4-5 best ideas and turn them into the actual sets. It sounds easier than it really is: the process from sketch to product takes around three months of intensive thinking and building!


(II) What research did you have to do before designing the sets?

We were allowed to use the Lucasfilm archive, of course, but for Indiana Jones, we more or less built what we thought would be cool sets. We're all huge fans of the movies, so everybody had the DVDs, and we had some books too. Plus, today you can find almost everything on the internet, so I'd say research was the easy part.

(P) How do you adapt a scene or vehicle from the movies to LEGO brick form?

The first thing to decide is what scene might be interesting for LEGO fans. Star Wars is very vehicle-based, so it's quite easy to make something kids will like even if they haven't seen the movies, but Indiana Jones is more character-based. You want to make sure that the set has features that any kid could play with.
