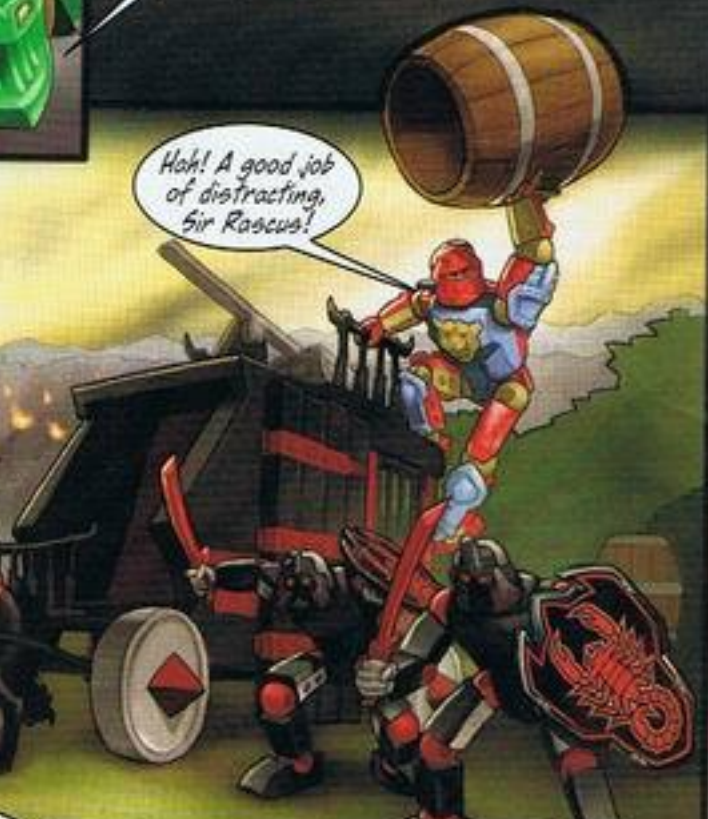

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The MIGHTY mobile crane!

Ever wonder how a crane works? Then let's take a closer look at my XXL Mobile Crane. But make sure you have a few minutes to spare - it's HUGE!



I use this hook to pick up heavy loads and move them around and up and down. The hook alone can weigh up to 4 tons (that's as much as an elephant!) to help lift those heavy loads and to stop the chain from getting tangled.



The most important part of the crane that helps reach the top of the tallest building and lift the heaviest loads is called a "boom". Funny, because that's the sound you hear if it drops something! The XXL Mobile Crane's boom can be raised and lowered just like the real thing.



The winch can be operated to raise and lower whatever is on the hook.



Rear view



No, the crane hasn't grown insect legs! These are outriggers, used to keep the crane from tipping over when it has a heavy load. I make sure they are extended before I go to work.

50 years ago, the LEGO® System of Play was born with a collection of 28 sets and 8 vehicles making up "Town Plan", a small village designed to teach children the rules of the road!



The National Trust for Historic Preservation, a group that preserves historic sites and re-builds communities, designated LEGO Town Plan "historic", recognizing its unique design and the history of creative inspiration LEGO building has provided to today's architects, innovators, creative leaders and preservationists. National Trust sites include Montpelier, the Virginia home of US Constitution father, James Madison, and architect Frank Lloyd Wright's home.

Kjeld Kirk Kristiansen (center-left), current LEGO Group owner, was 8 years old when Town Plan launched. Today, the LEGO System of Play includes 3,500 elements in 75 different colors, more than 100 themes and hundreds of unique minifigures, creating endless building possibilities for all ages.

HISTORY IN YOUR HANDS!



The National Trust for Historic Preservation celebrates and preserves historic architecture and design. Some popular architectural styles include:

Take a look around your town and see if you can find different architectural styles. Better yet, try to recreate historic architecture with your LEGO collection. Here are a few tips from the LEGO Master Builders:

LEGO Master Builder Erik Varszegi says, "To recreate the Prairie style, build low, horizontal buildings using LEGO plates for the roofs, staggering plates to create overhangs. For Neoclassical style, stack 2x2 bricks to create columns or use what we call "headlight" bricks and 1x1 round plates to add trim detail."



This Town Hall model, designed virtually by a fan in LEGO Factory, illustrates Neoclassical style.



A LEGO version of the Mark Twain House in Hartford, Connecticut, a great example of Queen Anne Style.



Frank Lloyd Wright's Robie House, a National Trust Historic Site on the University of Chicago campus, an example of his Prairie style.

Neoclassical Style: 1785-1815

Introduced by Thomas Jefferson and became popular for public buildings like banks, courthouses and churches. The White House is the most famous example of Neoclassical style!
Features: lots of columns, symmetrical design, masonry exteriors with marble accents and details
Most commonly Found: Northeast US

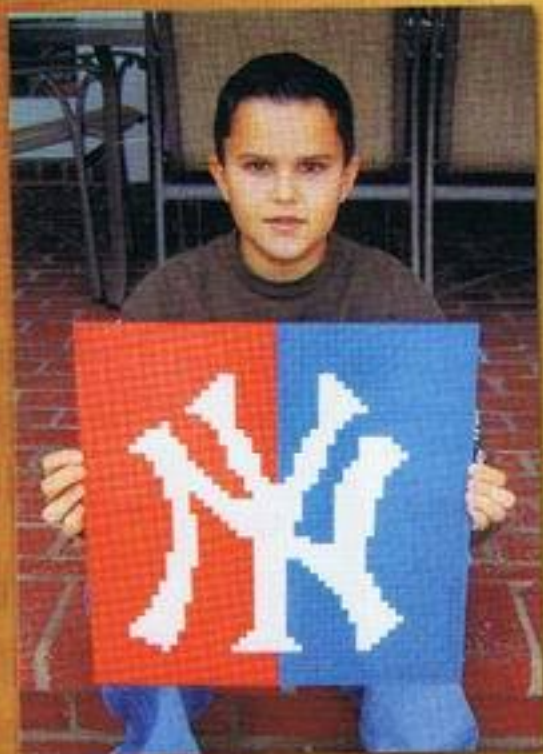
Queen Anne Style: 1880-1900

Emerged in England, combining classical ornament with medieval form.
Features: turrets, towers, gables and bays; brick or stone first floors, stucco or shingles on upper floors, huge chimneys, overhangs, porches and balconies
Most commonly Found: most major cities, including Philadelphia, Boston, San Francisco

Prairie Style: 1900-1920

Developed by famed architect Frank Lloyd Wright to reflect the Midwest Prairie landscape.
Features: horizontal appearance, low-pitched roofs with overhanging eaves, open interior floor plans, walls of light-colored brick, stucco or wood, stained glass windows
Most commonly Found: Illinois, Iowa and Wisconsin

LEGO® Hot Rod Building

Advice from *Monster Garage*.

The LEGO® Magazine caught up with custom-motorcycle builder Jesse James – star of the Discovery Channel's *Monster Garage* TV program – to ask a few questions about building cool cars and motorcycles with LEGO bricks.



Q. What sort of toys did you play with when you were a kid?

A. My parents were antique dealers so I had a lot of old Marx tin toys...and a bunch of LEGO® bricks.

Q. What advice would you give to a kid who wants to build the coolest LEGO hot rod he can?

A. Don't be afraid to build stuff that's not in the pictures. Build what's in your head.

Q. Do you prefer to work on custom cars or custom bikes?

A. Bikes!

Q. What advice would give kids who want to make their own real hot rods or motorcycles someday?

A. The only way to find out if you can do it or not is to try!

Q. What was your favorite project on *Monster Garage*, and why?

A. I think the Flying car! Because not one person thought I could do it...but I knew it might work!

Q. If you could design your own LEGO set, what would you want to make?

A. When I was a kid I was obsessed with LEGO bricks. I would lay on the floor for hours and build stuff. I didn't know that I would apply what I learned playing with LEGO bricks to what I do now. So I think we should make sets that encourage kids to use LEGO bricks to build skills that will carry them later in life. Like a hot rod shop set where you can build your own rod, or a chopper set, or a low-rider set. Instead of giving clear cut instructions on how to do it, we should have people use their imagination and creativity to come up with stuff on their own!

Q. How about jumps? Did you ever send a LEGO motorcycle over any ramps?

A. No. It was too small for me to ride!

Q. Would you consider a LEGO building challenge against either a kid LEGO Maniac or a LEGO Designer/Master Model Builder?

A. Lets make a real chopper out of LEGO bricks! I know, I can do it! I'll ride it!

Q. Do you think playing with LEGO bricks fuelled your interest in tinkering in the monster garage to create custom choppers?

A. If it wasn't for LEGO bricks there would be no *Monster Garage*.
