



Q: Tell us about your job, Jens!

A: I'm a design manager responsible for the development of LEGO® Star Wars™ models. I work with Lucasfilm to make sure that the models are approved and accurate to the original designs.

Q: How many sets have you designed for LEGO Star Wars?

A: I have been working on LEGO Star Wars for ten years now, and I love to build, so I don't know exactly how many sets I've made...but it's a lot! The one I am most proud of is

#10179 Ultimate Collector's Millennium Falcon, as it is the biggest LEGO set ever made, with more than 5,000 bricks!

Q: Were you excited about getting to work on LEGO Star Wars?

A: I am definitely a Star Wars fan, and I have always loved the movies. So when it was decided that we would make LEGO Star Wars, I did everything I could to get assigned to the project... and here I am!

Q: How did you decide which The Clone Wars vehicles to make as LEGO sets?

A: We worked together with Lucas Licensing to decide. They knew which vehicles would be important in The Clone Wars movie and TV show. and we knew which ones would be fun to play with.

Q: How do you know what features and characters to include in a model?

A: We want to include figures that go with the model in the story. We like to make cool new figures for sets whenever we can. The features and functions are usually based on what we see on the screen, but sometimes we are creative and invent our own to make the model even more fun.

Q: Tell us about the process of designing a new LEGO Star Wars model!

A: We decide on the assortment together with Lucasfilm. Then we start

We wanted to give LEGO Club members a special inside peek at the making of these action-packed new sets, so we sat down for a Q&A with model designer Jens Kronvold Frederiksen to talk about how a LEGO Star Wars set is made!



building sketch models (early versions to give us an idea of what the final set might look like). The models that we like the most then go through a lot of different processes to make sure that they look right, are fun to build, don't fall apart, etc. These final models are sent to Lucas Licensing for final approval. At the same time, we make any new bricks or other elements that are needed for the models. They all have to be approved by Lucas, too.

## Q: In your own words, tell us all about some of the newest LEGO Star Wars sets!

A: For the second half of 2008, I designed #7675 AT-TE and the exclusive #7681 Homing Spider Droid. The Homing Spider Droid is fun because the legs move when you lift and move the model, and you can do some fun things with that. The AT-TE model has two hidden rocket launchers in the front that you can use to shoot the STAP and battle droid. It takes a little practice to hit the STAP, but it's a lot of fun!





#### Q: What do you think of the new *The Clone Wars* movie and tv series?

A: It's great! There are so many cool vehicles and a LOT of lightsaber battles!

#### Q: What's your favorite Star Wars movie?

A: It's hard to say, because they are all different, but I think that Episode III and Episode V are my favorites. I especially like the battle on Hoth with snowspeeders and AT-ATs, and in Episode III, all the battles and General Grievous are very cool.

#### Q: If you could make anything you wanted from the Star Wars universe out of LEGO bricks, what would it be?

A: Well, I think we ARE pretty much making everything from the Star Wars universe! But a huge Super Star Destroyer would be fun.

Q: Finally, can you give us any hints about future LEGO Star Wars sets that you're working on?

A: Sorry, you'll just have to wait and see!
